Shri Abhishek Tyagi received his M.Sc. (Applied Geology) from Kurukshetra University and M.Tech. (Remote Sensing) from Birla Institute of Technology. Shri Tyagi has been associated with the National Centre for Antarctic and Ocean Research (NCAOR), Goa since 2004.

Shri Tyagi, currently working as Scientist-C, has more than 12 years of experience in all facets of marine topographic surveys and has participated in more than 40 cruises totaling nearly 1000 days at High Seas in Arabian Sea, Bay

of Bengal, Central Indian Ocean, Southern Ocean and Antarctic region. He has successfully led and coordinated 18 expeditions for International Collaborative and major National programmes.
