Dr. Babula Jena, Scientist 'E' at the National Centre for Polar and Ocean Research, Ministry of Earth Sciences obtained his Ph.D in Marine Science with remote sensing specialisation from Berhampur University. He took a lead role in undertaking scientific works on satellite remote sensing applications for advance understanding the variability of Antarctic sea-ice and phytoplankton bloom in the Southern Ocean, under the warming climate.

He has contributed to various national and international programmes such as the

Southern Ocean Program/Antarctic expedition, mapping of the Indian EEZ, and Hydrothermal mineralization studies in the Central-Indian-Ridge & Southwest-Indian-Ridge. He has studied the potential application of satellite altimetry and multibeam swath bathymetric survey for identification, mapping and interpretation of various geomorphic features. Dr. Jena has taken a lead role as a Chief Scientist in various scientific expeditions.
