INVESTMENT IN DEEP SEA MISSION

1007. SHRI MAJEED MEMON:

Will the Minister of EARTH SCIENCES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that Government is planning to invest ₹ 10,000 crores in Deep Sea Missions, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) how Government proposes to utilize the 2.4 million sq. km. of Exclusive Economic Zone; and
- (c) whether the expertise of foreign companies will be invited for collaboration with Indian companies for the Deep Sea Mission?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR MINISTRY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY AND MINISTRY OF EARTH SCIENCES (SHRI. Y. S. CHOWDARY)

- (a) Yes, Sir, Government proposes to launch a Deep Ocean Mission. Development of technologies for exploration and harnessing of living and non-living resources, survey and exploration of deep sea and development of marine bio-technology are the broad objectives of this mission. The cost of the Mission has not been worked out.
- (b) Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas (MoPNG) and Ministry of Mines (MoM) allocate blocks in the Exclusive Economic Zone of India for exploration of hydrocarbons and minerals.
- (c) The Deep Ocean Mission envisages active involvement and collaboration of national and international institutes/organisations. At this stage, Ministry does not have any proposal for collaboration of Indian companies with foreign companies for the Deep Sea Mission.
