

DEPARTMENT OF OCEAN DEVELOPMENT

New Delhi, the 21st September, 2001

G.S.R. 563.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Department of Ocean Development (Senior Technical Assistant) Recruitment Rules, 1993 and Sagar Sampada Cell, Cochin (Senior Technical Assistant) Recruitment Rules, 1993 published in the Gazette of India Part II Section 3, sub-section (i) vide number G S R. 544 dated the 30th November, 1996 and G S R. 20 dated 1st January, 1994 respectively and except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Senior Technical Assistant in the Department of Ocean Development, namely :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Department of Ocean Development (Senior Technical Assistant) Recruitment Rules, 2001.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.**—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed hereto.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the said Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.**—No person—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this Rule.

5. **Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Ex-servicemen Other Backward Classes Other Special categories of persons in accordance with the Orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

Note : 1 The qualification(s) regarding experience is/are relaxable at the discretion of competent authority in the case of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes and the Scheduled Tribes if, at any stage of selection the competent authority is of the opinion that sufficient number of candidates from these communities possessing the requisite experience are not likely to be available to fill up the posts reserved for them.

Note 2 : The required areas of experience shall be specified according to specific requirement of the post at the time of recruitment.

(a) (i) holding analogous posts or (ii) 3 years in the scale of Rs. 5000-8000 or (iii) with 6 years service in the scale of Rs. 4500-7000/- or (iv) with 10 years regular service in the scale of Rs. 4,000—6,000/- and (b) possessing the educational qualifications and experience prescribed for direct recruits under column 8.

(The period of deputation including period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organisation/Department of the Central Government shall ordinarily not exceed three years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation/absorption shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 1: The official should not be absorbed before the last year of normal deputation tenure.

Note 2: The official will be re-evaluated by the Departmental Promotion Committee prescribed under Col. 13 before permanently absorbing in the Department.

Note 3: Only officers of Central Government/State Governments are eligible for being considered for absorption.

सा.का. नि. 564 :—राष्ट्रपति, संविधान के अनुच्छेद 309 के परन्तुक द्वारा प्रदत्त शक्तियों का प्रयोग करते हुए और महासागर विकास विभाग (लेखाकार) भर्ती नियम, 1985 को जो भारत के राजपत्र भाग 2, खंड 3, उपखंड (i) में सा.का.नि. 386, तारीख 13 अप्रैल, 1985 द्वारा प्रकाशित किए गए थे, उन बातों के सिवाए अधिक्रांत करते हुए जिन्हें ऐसे अधिक्रमण से पहले किया गया है या करने का लोप किया गया है, महासागर विकास विभाग में (लेखाकार) के पदों पर भर्ती की पद्धति का विनियमन करने के लिए निम्नलिखित नियम बनाते हैं, अर्थात् :—

1. संक्षिप्त नाम और प्रारंभ :—(1) इन नियमों का संक्षिप्त नाम महासागर विकास विभाग (लेखाकार) भर्ती नियम, 2001 है।
(2) ये राजपत्र में प्रकाशन की तारीख को प्रवृत्त होंगे।
2. पद संख्या, वर्गीकरण और वेतनमान :—उक्त पद की संख्या उसका वर्गीकरण और उसका वेतनमान वह होगा, जो इन नियमों से उपाबद्ध अनुसूची के स्तंभ 2 से स्तंभ 4 में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।
3. भर्ती की पद्धति, आयु-सीमा, अर्हताएं आदि :—उक्त पद पर भर्ती की पद्धति, आयु-सीमा, और अन्य अर्हताएं और उससे संबंधित अन्य बातें वे होंगी जो उक्त अनुसूची के स्तंभ 5 से स्तंभ 14 में विनिर्दिष्ट हैं।
4. निरर्हता :—वह व्यक्ति—
(क) जिसने ऐसे व्यक्ति से, जिसका पति या जिसकी पत्नी जीवित है, विवाह किया है, या
(ख) जिसने अपने पति या अपनी पत्नी के जीवित रहते हुए किसी व्यक्ति से विवाह किया है,

उक्त पद पर नियुक्ति का पात्र नहीं होगा :

परन्तु यदि केन्द्रीय सरकार का यह समाधान हो जाता है कि ऐसा विवाह ऐसे व्यक्ति और विवाह के अन्य पक्षकार को लागू स्वीय विधि से अधीन अनुज्ञेय है और ऐसा करने के लिए अन्य आधार हैं तो वह किसी व्यक्ति को इस नियम के प्रवर्तन से छूट दे सकेगी।

5. शिथिल करने की शक्ति :—जहां केन्द्रीय सरकार की यह राय है कि ऐसा करना आवश्यक या समीचीन है, वहां वह उसके लिए जो कारण हैं उन्हें लेखबद्ध करके इन नियमों के किसी उपबंध को किसी वर्ग या प्रवर्ग के व्यक्तियों की बाबत, आदेश द्वारा शिथिल कर सकेगी।

G.S.R. 901(E)— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Secretariat Clerical Services Rules, 1962, namely:-

1. (1) These rules may be called the Central Secretariat Clerical Service (Amendment) Rules, 2010.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. In the Central Secretariat Clerical Service Rules, 1962, -

- (i) for rule 5, the following rule shall be substituted, namely :-

"5. Authorised sanctioned strength .- (1) The authorized sanctioned strength of the two grades of the service in each cadre as on the 3rd October, 2003, shall be as specified in the Second Schedule.

(2) After the 3rd October, 2003, the authorised sanctioned strength of the two grades in each cadre shall be such as may be determined by the Central Government from time to time.";

- (ii) in rule 12, for sub-rule (1), the following sub-rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"(1) All the vacant posts in the Lower Division Grade of the service as on the 3rd October, 2003 falling under direct recruitment quota (80% of which were hitherto filled on the basis of competitive examination held by the Staff Selection Commission and 5% on the basis of selection made by the Staff Selection Commission from amongst the outstanding sports-men) shall stand abolished and eighty five percent. of the vacancies falling in the aforesaid categories in the Lower Division Grade in each cadre on the 3rd October, 2003 or subsequently, shall continue to be abolished every year by the cadre controlling authorities till the authorised sanctioned strength in the grade is brought to a level of fifteen percent. of the authorised sanctioned strength as on 3rd

October, 2003 in each cadre unit and the remaining number of vacancies every year shall be filled in the Lower Division Grade, in each cadre unit, by appointment of Group 'C' employees having grade pay of Rs. 1800 borne on regular establishments working in the Ministries and offices participating in the Central Secretariat Clerical Service, in the following manner, namely: -

- ✓ (a) seventy percent. of the said vacancies shall be filled on the basis of seniority, subject to rejection of the unfit, from amongst those Group 'C' employees who have rendered not less than three years' 'regular service' as Group 'C' employee in the posts with Grade Pay of Rs. 1800 having minimum qualification of 10th standard pass or equivalent qualification as prescribed in model recruitment rules for Group 'C' posts.
- (b) thirty percent of the said vacancies shall be filled on the basis of 'Limited Departmental Competitive Examination for Group 'C' staff' conducted by the Staff Selection Commission in which Group 'C' employees who have passed the 12th standard examination from a recognised Board or equivalent and have rendered not less than three years' 'regular service' as Group 'C' employee having Grade Pay of Rs. 1800 shall be eligible to participate.";

(iii) rule 12 A and rule 12 B shall be omitted;

(iv) in rule 17, in sub-rule (3), under the heading "II Lower Division Grade" and the entries relating thereto, the following shall be substituted, namely:-

" II. LOWER DIVISION GRADE

The inter-se seniority of persons appointed on regular basis to the Grade shall be regulated in the following manner, namely:-

- (a) those appointed under clause (a) of sub-rule (1) of rule 12 shall rank inter-se in the order of their seniority in the lower Grade;
- (b) those appointed under clause (b) of sub-rule (1) of rule 12 shall rank inter-se in the order as recommended by the Staff Selection Commission;
- (c) the inter-se seniority of persons referred to in clauses (a) and (b) shall be regulated according to the quota fixed for each of the two groups, in accordance with a roster maintained by each cadre authority, starting with seven persons referred to in clause (a) followed by three from clause (b) above and so on.";
- (v) for the Second Schedule, the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely:-
