4. Kindly provide a copy of the approval of the Governing Council of NIOT for the Recruitment Rules as required by DoPT OM No. AB.14017/11/2004-Estt. (RR) dated 30.7.2007.	Recruitment Rules for Director/Autonomous Institute are formulated by the Administrative Ministry, as per the referred DoPT OM. Hence the sought information is factually incorrect.



5. Kindly inform reasons recorded by the Governing Council of NIOT, if any, for diluting the minimum requirement from PhD, which has been used since 1994 to the post graduate qualification now.

Since information sought apparently pertains to Governing Council/NIOT, CPIO/NIOT may be approached for the same.

6. Kindly provide a copy of the approval of the Recruitment Rules by DoPT.

Approval of DoPT is not required for Recruitment Rules in respect of Autonomous Institutes. Hence the sought information is factually incorrect.

7. Kindly provide a copy of the approval for the creation of the post of Director, NIOT by the Ministry of Finance.

Post creation approval related documents of NIOT in the erstwhile Department of Ocean Development, being very old, are being searched and shall be provided as they become available.

Normally the highest-level post in an Autonomous Institute is designated as Director to head the Institute.

A copy of notification issued by DoPT regarding application of provision of Administrative Tribunal Act, 1985 in respect of Autonomous Institutes (which includes NIOT) is enclosed. CPIO/NIOT may also be approached for the sought information.

8. It is seen that the pay scale of Director is the same as that of Scientist-G of the Ministry. However, the requirement in the case of experience has been grossly diluted by removing the requirement of minimum 5 years of experience in the grade of Scientist-F or equivalent. Handbook for personnel officers - 2013 of DoPT requires prior concurrence of Ministry of Finance to alterations in service rules, see item 3.6. As the pay scales agreed to by the Ministry of Finance are on the basis of the qualifications and other requirements laid down for the respective posts, any alterations in the Service Rules applicable to any cadre, which will have the effect of lowering the qualifications below those laid down when the Service Scheme was sanctioned and the pay scales were agreed to by the Ministry of Finance, should receive the prior concurrence of that Ministry.

There is no downgrading of norms for Director/Autonomous Institute as compared to the norms for Scientist-G in MoES. Hence the sought information is factually incorrect.

It is stated that as a general principle, the basic qualification for the same level of posts is similar but qualification above the basic may be altered as per the specific requirement of any particular post, for which the Administrative Ministry is competent.

Kindly provide a copy of concurrence of Ministry of Finance to alterations in Service Rules.

9. Kindly inform whether a candidate selected for the post can draw full salary if he opts to take VRS from his earlier service and draw Pension and Dearness Relief.

- 3. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications, etc.

 The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters related to the said post shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.
- 4. Disqualification No person,
 - a. Who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
 - b. Who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied, that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- 5. Power to relax:-Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect of any class or category of persons.
- 6. Saving:-Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
